Drop/Add Policy

Students wishing to drop a course must wait until 5th week of the 1st or 2nd semester. Students may also drop full year classes at semester. To drop a class at any of these times, student will complete a *Drop Form* and obtain the appropriate permissions. If a drop is requested at any other times than the 5th week or at semester, the drop may be considered a failure and an “F” may be recorded on the transcript (calculated into rank and GPA)

After June 8, 2018, there will be no further schedule changes except for individual circumstances such as students needing to meet graduation requirements.
